The Enemy's "Advanced", "Intermediate" and "Main" lines will be known from their lettering as the "XZ line", "WD line" and "T line" respectively. Their letterings are taken from the 1:50,000 maps, "Enemy's O trenches", "Trenches NW of Doiran" and "B.G.1.2 ^A ." Note attached to the map by Bill Jackson: "Note - bloodstained so I assume he (Bill Jackson's father) had this on him when he was wounded in the 2nd Battle of Doiran. Note the pencil marks around P4 1/2, 4, 3. I remember him saying that the wire was supposed to have been cut by the artillery prior to the attack but when they reached it, it was as good as the day it had been put in place. I think the marks indicate where the wire was intended to be breached.
